The progeny's performance on the racetrack could add millions of dollars to the value of their sire if successful. It also could mean the end of many dreams of having the next great sire if they under-perform on the track.

When asked for her turn of foot entering the stretch, SAL-VAJE went wide and then wider to the untouched outer grass for clear sailing past the front-runner.

Hernandez commented, "SALVAJE felt good out there. She was very keen the first part of the race, but I was able

Do you have a favorite racetrack?


Keeneland is by far our top pick, with Saratoga placing second.
