**BOUT TIME**, making her turf debut, broke her maiden in style by 5 ½ lengths at Fair Grounds. With Brian Hernandez Jr. up, she pulled away down the stretch for a visually impressive win.



**SACHEM**, making her second career start, recovered from a poor break and came widest of all to win in comfortable fashion over the Turfway Park synthetic surface. Sachem was claimed for \$30,000



BAYERNESS took Churchill Downs' \$139,400 Roxelana Overnight Stakes by the most comfortable 4½ lengths under Luis Saez. Bayerness was coming off a nearly nine-month layoff after winning the Shine Again S. at Saratoga.

**SALVAJE**, fresh off of back-to-back placings in allowance company at Fair Grounds, won a \$110,000 allowance race at Keeneland with a come-from-behind, narrow victory in a dramatic three-way battle to the wire.



**BOUT TIME** put an authoritative move on her rivals down the stretch to win a \$127,000 allowance at Churchill Downs by an easy 2 3/4 lengths under Brian Hernandez Jr., who has ridden her to a pair of wins and a narrow second thus far in 2022.



**BOUT TIME** earned black-type in June as she dominated in her stakes debut, the \$108,000 Goldwood S. at Monmouth Park. Her easy 2 1/4-length victory pushed her turf record to 4-3-1-0. This daughter of Not This Time is a half-sister to three stakes horses, including multiple stakes winner Archidust (\$520,702).





DAME CINCO was an easy 2 1/2-length winner at one mile over Saratoga's main track in mid-August. She broke well and stalked the pace to the quarter-pole, then took command down the stretch under Luis Saez. It was nice to have several partners in the Saratoga winner's circle celebration.



PROUVER broke her maiden at Horseshoe Indianapolis in her second career start. The uniquely colored gray overcame an awkward start, hooked a stubborn rival at the sixteenth pole while widest of all, and then gamely out-kicked that foe to win by a nose.



**VAHVA** lived up to her name when breaking her maiden with ease on the day Churchill Downs dubbed "Stars of Tomorrow," a full card exclusively for 2-year-olds. Vahva broke well and tracked the pace from the start, took the lead entering the stretch and drew clear by three lengths for a commanding win in her third outing.
